

Medical Rehabilitation in Germany

Several aspects of medical rehabilitation services in Germany are unique. The historic basis and legislation over more than one century contribute to this situation. Because the German rehabilitation system is successful, but rather complex and not easy to understand for persons from other countries the German Society for Rehabilitation Sciences organized a session at the 9th World Congress of the *International Society of Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine (ISPRM)* 2015 in Berlin.
